Energy assistance still available to Washington residents

Community Action Partnership knows that each year, many Asotin County residents need a little help making ends meet. Washington energy assistance programs can help when you need it most—right now!

If your household has not received energy assistance since November 2009 and is within the income limits listed below, you may qualify to receive from \$50 to \$1000 toward your energy bill.

Households who qualify consist of:

- 1 individual with a maximum monthly income of \$1128
- 2 individuals with a maximum monthly household income of \$1518
- 3 individuals with a maximum monthly household income of \$1907
- 4 individuals with a maximum monthly household income of \$2297

Please contact your local Community Action Partnership regarding income limits for larger households.
